The Vision of Rev. Pastor Paul Fatile Lasseur



From Haiti to the Great Bahamas, Pastor Lasseur launched a campaign of missionary works to proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ. In 1975, he left the Bahamas for the United States to continue the work of ministry among those who left Bahamas to immigrate to the United States in South Florida. In 1977, he incorporated the church in the State of Florida as Bethany Baptist Missionary Society, Inc.

In the Early 80s, he started a new ministry in Fort Lauderdale to expand the kingdom of God to Broward County. Two years later, a group of people split the church and left pastor Lasseur with a handful of people no greater than 10.

A Renewed Commitment...

He recruited new missionaries from the mother church in Miami to help the church in Fort Lauderdale. God heard the plea of Pastor Lasseur for a church where the sound doctrine of the gospel of Jesus Christ is preached. In 1984, the church ordained brother Usler Auguste to be the pastor of the church.

Pastor Wilson Usler Auguste led Église Baptiste Béthanie de Fort Lauderdale from its infancy through its explosive development and growth. Under his leadership, the church built the most beautiful church building in the Fort Lauderdale area. The Temple is built on 10 acres of land that the members purchased in 1989. In April 1995, the temple was dedicated to God for His people to worship Him. He served the church church faithfully until his passing in July 2014.

The Vision of Pastor Dr. John Wesley Hyacinthe



After the passing of pastor Usler Auguste, the church reached out to brother John Wesley Hyacinthe who resided in Washington State at that time. Brother John Wesley left everything behind in Washington to help the church crossed that difficult journey. From 2015 to 2017, He led a council to amend the church constitution to include the process of choosing a new pastor for the church. In January 2017, the church approved the constitution overwhelmingly with 94% of the members voted YES.

After a long fight in the implementation of the constitution leading to the ordination of brother John Wesley, the church knew a heartbroken split in September 2019. Three months

later the church made the worst experience of persecution from the wife of the late pastor Auguste. The Christian Church History never registered such act of persecution, even from Jezebel, the wife of king Ahab (874–853 B.C.).

In September 2020, the church ordained and installed brother Dr. John Wesley Hyacinthe as the pastor of the church to lead the people of God. From Day 1, pastor John Wesley tackled the root of the problem that caused the church to experience this nightmare. We are confident, with the help of the Holy Spirit, that Béthanie will never make such a bitter experience. Dr. John Wesley is committed to equip the church for the work of ministry. Servant Leadership is the lifestyle of Dr. Hyacinthe. And whoever is called and desires to become a leader in the church, he must love God and walk the talk (practice what you preach), be a gifted leader, and have a heart of service.
